

# ACADEMY SPOUSES' CLUB 2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

All applicants must submit the following information for the application to be considered complete. Any application missing the required information and documentation will NOT be considered or judged. The completed application must be postmarked and mailed to the Scholarship Committee **no later than 15 March 2024.** Application includes:

- 1. An essay, typewritten in 12-point Times New Roman font, double spaced and limited to one page.
- 2. Pages 1-5 of the scholarship application.
- 3. The certification page, dated and signed by the applicant.
- 4. All supplementary documents including official transcripts.
- 5. Affidavit form signed by the sponsor.
- 6. A color copy of the front and back of the applicant's military ID.

### Eligibility

### Each applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Applicants must attend an accredited college, university, or vocational school during the 2024-2025 academic year.
- 2. Applicants must be the dependent (high school senior, currently enrolled college student, non-military spouse) of an active duty, reserve, guard, retired, MIA/POW, deceased officer or enlisted member of the US Military residing in El Paso or Teller counties only.
- 3. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA based on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. Applicants may not have previously accepted an ASC scholarship.

### Limitations

- 1. Scholarship funds are to be used during the 2024-2025 academic year.
- 2. All funds received will be applied to tuition, tuition-related fees, and books only.
- 3. Payments of scholarship awards will be made directly to the college, university or vocational school. The recipient must provide the Scholarship Committee with the name and address of the school. This information, along with the Enrollment Verification Form, must be postmarked by **14 October 2024**, or the award will be returned to the ASC Welfare account.
- 4. The scholarship award, when combined with other scholarships, must not exceed the cost of tuition, tuition-related fees, and books. Any remaining funds must be returned to the ASC Welfare Fund.
- 5. Applicants accepting an appointment to a US military service academy or accepting a full scholarship, must notify the ASC Scholarship Committee immediately and forfeit the ASC scholarship.
- 6. Prior recipients of an ASC scholarship are not eligible to apply for or receive a second ASC scholarship.

- 1. Scholarship funds will be used for post-secondary studies within the 2024-2025 academic year and will be applied to tuition, tuition-related fees, and books only. Excess funds will be returned to the ASC Welfare Fund.
- 2. I have until **01 May 2024** to complete and return the Notice of Acceptance of Award. In failing to do so, I forfeit the award and it will be returned to the ASC Welfare Fund.
- 3. As a scholarship recipient, I must submit the name and address of the school I will be attending during the 2024-2025 academic year along with the Verification of Enrollment Form (completed by the college, university, or accredited technical school) to the ASC Scholarship Committee no later than **14 October 2024**.
- 4. After receiving the Notice of Acceptance of Award letter and the Enrollment Verification Form, the award, and a letter with the terms of the scholarship will be mailed directly to the college or university.
- 5. The scholarship award, when combined with other scholarships, must not exceed the cost of tuition, tuition-related fees, and books. Any remaining funds will be returned to the ASC Welfare Fund as soon as possible.
- 6. If I accept an appointment to a military service academy or receive a full scholarship to include tuition, tuition-related fees, and books, I understand that I am ineligible to receive this award.
- 7. I am responsible for notifying the ASC Scholarship Committee of any change of status (e.g. change of schools, change of address, etc...) Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of my scholarship award.
- 8. Unclaimed funds as of **14 October 2024** revert to the ASC Welfare Fund.
- 9. If any of the above conditions are violated, I will return any scholarship awards to the ASC Welfare Fund.
